

# NIH PUBLIC ACCESS POLICY COMPLIANCE

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR MCW RESEARCHERS

The 2024 NIH Public Access Policy requires NIH-funded authors to make their accepted manuscripts publicly available in PubMed Central (PMC) immediately upon official publication, without an embargo period.

### CONFIRM JOURNAL POLICIES

- Before submitting your manuscript to a publisher, confirm that publisher policies allow you to comply with NIH Policy.
- Check the journal's website or the [PMC Journal List](#) to see if the journal automatically deposits NIH-funded articles into PubMed Central (PMC) **upon publication date** (Method A).
- While authors are not mandated to pay Article Processing Charges (APCs) to comply with the NIH Public Access Policy, many publisher agreements will not allow you to comply **without** paying an APC. Also, publishing open access does not automatically achieve compliance, your article needs to be deposited in PMC without an embargo..

### ACKNOWLEDGE NIH FUNDING

- Include a statement acknowledging NIH funding in your manuscript, adhering to the NIH Grants Policy Statement.

### SUBMIT TO PUBMED CENTRAL

- When choosing a journal, check how it complies with the NIH Public Access Policy:
  - Method A: **Publisher** automatically deposits the final published article in PMC.
  - Method B: **Author** arranges for **publisher** to deposit final published article in PMC.
  - Method C: **Author** submits, reviews, and approves the accepted manuscript for PMC via the NIH Manuscript Submission System (NIHMS).
  - Method D: **Publisher** submits the accepted manuscript in NIHMS, **author** reviews and approves PMC-formatted manuscript.

### INCLUDE PMCID IN CITATIONS

- Compliance with the 2024 NIH Public Access Policy is demonstrated by the PubMed Central ID (PMCID) for the deposited manuscript without Embargo.
- The PMCID must be cited in subsequent applications, proposals, and reports submitted to the NIH.

### CHECK COMPLIANCE

- You can monitor the compliance status of your articles in "My Bibliography" in My NCBI, linked to your eRA Commons account.
